Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

10.2 Alcohol -- Responsible

As a result of the incident that occurred on September 3, 2019, where Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority chapter members hosted an event in which alcohol was provided for underage members, your organization has submitted an Enhancement Plan. This will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Greek Life/Campus Life and Student Advocacy & Accountability:

Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective January 23, 2020 through December 31, 2020. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning could be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

1. Following the incident, no further chapter events were or will be held at the chapter members' residence that the incident occurred at.
2. The chapter will host a leadership day for incoming officers facilitated by KKG specialists. During the workshop, officers will also evaluate social events with alcohol. Attendance and agenda will be submitted to SAA by **February 14, 2020**.
3. Chapter members will attend a workshop on KKG and LSU risk management and social event policies. 85% of membership is required to attend. Attendance and agenda will be submitted to SAA by **March 2, 2020**.
4. The executive board will develop an alternative sisterhood event at the KKG house on fraternity bid day. Plan due to SAA by **May 1, 2020**.

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the [online reporting form](#) or via email to [REDACTED].

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy &

Accountability within the Office of the Dean of Students. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff. We encourage you to share this information with your Headquarters staff.
